"At The Inn, you're always greeted by smiling faces. Everyone at The Inn is dealing with something, and you don't feel different. You are not stared at. Adults and children see you for you, not your illness. They are trying to get to know you, not your disease. That's an amazing feeling. For my mom, The Inn also showed her that she wasn't alone as a caretaker.

Thanks to the NIH's Undiagnosed Diseases Program, my case is being studied by doctors around the world, and I hope that one day, there'll be someone who can help me get a diagnosis – or that my case can at least help other children like me get a diagnosis and a treatment that works."

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Inn residents and their families have partnered with NIH researchers to advance the diagnosis and treatment of life-threatening diseases, including cancer, rare autoimmune conditions, cystic fibrosis, and blood disorders. Examples of the remarkable medical breakthroughs that have resulted from this partnership include:

- Curing 90% of children with the most common form of blood cancer and using advances such as CAR–T cell therapy to cure young patients with advanced leukemia.
- Demonstrating bone marrow transplants cure sickle cell disease.
- Advancing new ways to diagnose and treat serious mental health conditions, such as schizophrenia and depression in children and adolescents.
- Pioneering effective treatments for many rare and serious genetic diseases.
- Making HIV/AIDS a treatable disease.

The Inn typically **serves 1,500+** patients annually; the lower number in recent years is due to the COVID-19 pandemic, during which most clinical trials were suspended. Families have come from **50** states and **106** countries to help advance medical discoveries. Over the past year, our program support provided **728** occurrences of therapeutic, educational, and recreational family programs, including exercise classes, therapy dog visits, sports programs, art, tutoring, cooking, field trips, and special events.
